Guest Speaker



Sharon K. Moss Moss Motors CEO

Sharon Moss began her entrepreneurial experience as a teenager when she worked for her father in one of his retail businesses. She began packing groceries in his grocery store, later graduated to selling clothes and later on women's shoes. Her father was an Automobile Dealer as well and she worked in the dealership's office, where she learned quickly that customer service was vitally important to success in retail. Later she worked for Lafayette's Oil Center, first as a secretary, then later as an oil buyer for a major oil company. Her last formal job was with a local television station as an account representative selling advertising. During this time, she also handled Moss Motors advertising as well. Her ability to please customers, while producing commercials garnered her the top sales position during her tenure at KADN television.

Sharon's involvement in the community has always been an important part of her life. She was first docent at the Lafayette Natural History Museum and Planetarium, and later served on its board of directors.

Sharon has also served as a board member of Acadiana Center for the Arts, American Cancer Society, University of Louisiana Foundation, Smith Family Teen Center, Acadiana Symphony

Women's League, University Art Museum, Hospice of Acadiana, Acadiana Cares, Spay & Neuter Clinic, Women's Leadership Council and she has graciously been involved with the Boys & Girls Club as a major sponsor for the Running of the Ducks for 16 years. Sharon was the Philanthropist of the year and Moss Motors garnered the Better business Bureau's Integrity Award for large business. She was Chairman for the American Heart Associations Go Red for Women Luncheon, Chairman for the American Cancer Society Viva La Cure and the American Cancer Society White Linen Gala. She has served as a mentor for Young Business Professionals of the 705 Club.

Her professional affiliations include the Lafayette Automobile Dealers Association, Louisiana Automobile Dealers Association and American International Automobile Dealers Association.

Sharon was nominated for dealer of the year for the state of Louisiana in 1998 and again in 2007, and was named Dealer of the Year for the State of Louisiana for 2007. She says this award is her most prestigious award, as she is the first woman ever in our state to receive this award. Sharon was also nominated for dealer of the year for 2 years in a row with the American International Automobile Dealers Association.

Sharon was a recipient of the Business Hall of Fame Laureate Award.

Sharon also served as Chairperson for the Go Red for Women Luncheon to benefit American Heart Association. Through her efforts they were able to raise the most money in the state of Louisiana.

Sharon has served as secretary- treasurer for the Lafayette Automobile Dealers Association. She was highlighted in Honda's "Insight Magazine" as a female dealer who has achieved top sales volume in her market consistently and also was spotlighted in Lafayette's Acadiana @ Work as CEO of the month, and was named to the Independents "Women Who Mean Business". Sharon was actively involved with the Tennis Associations of Lafayette Ladies (TALL) and was chairperson of their annual style show for two years. In April of 2010, she was profiled as one of Lafayette's leading ladies in L Magazine and she graced the cover of Face Magazine with a story about her overcoming adversity as a women in business.

Sharon Moss has served and continues to serve her community with gregarious enthusiasm for life, and is always willing to go the extra mile and likes being creative in these endeavors. Moss Motors is present in many endeavors to raise funds for civic and cultural events as well as donations to causes, which benefit individuals. Sharon's belief in giving back to the community is strong and she believes that giving back is part of her success. Sharon says "I feel so honored to be able to give back to my community, and I thank God for all the blessing he has bestowed on me."
